IIET Library

The IIET library is taking more shape by the Grace of Allah. We recall that with the help of HWL and SIM collaboration, the area was cleaned, books were rearranged as per categories and 1987 books of various languages have been input on an online library system (Librarika). Currently, SIM has been working with University Des Mascareignes where two students have done their project based on our IIET library (library system) and now they are doing their internship to customize the library system for our needs. The e-SIM team alhamdullilah is accompanying the students to complete their internship. We hope in the near future to have a fully operational library system at IIET to serve the ummah.



Induction Course for new/potential members

On 30th and 31st January 2021, SIM held an Induction Course for potential and new members of the movement at the Hotel de Deux Mondes, Choisy. 36 young persons, male and female who have been involved over the last few years in different activities organised by the movement were invited to attend.

The rationale behind the course was as follows:

SIM has been in existence as a movement in the Mauritian landscape for the past 45 years. Whereas its ideology was clear to all at the time of its inception, and training of members adapted to the needs of the time, happenings in recent history, both internationally and locally, coupled with the onslaught of various ideologies from authoritarian systems and narrow minded views of influential individuals, may have somewhat blurred the relevance and purpose of the Islamic movement in the minds of the general public.

SIM is neither a benevolent association nor an entertainment outlet nor a social club. It is rather a dynamic entity which promotes the application of the principles of Islam in the daily life of human beings by propagating and contextualizing the directives contained in the Qur'an and their application following the example of Prophet Muhammad (SAW), perfect model for humanity until the end of times.

Therefore, there is a need for new and potential members to be acquainted with the way of SIM, both as a voice and a way for the contemporary generation of Muslims in Mauritius.

An Induction Course is an essential element in any organisation's success as it creates the ground on which every person in the organisation builds on. Induction is the process of introducing new volunteers (or staff) to the **organisation**, their **role**, the **tasks**, the **skills required** and the other **people they will work with**. It is important to settle new volunteers into their role so that they know what they are doing and feel comfortable.



This is the first contact with the new life of a newcomer into an established team. So getting it right has a tremendous effect on the enthusiasm of members in any department. It is also the first impression that new recruits build about the organisation and it is a great means to confirm a better level of engagement within any team and, ultimately, create a higher volunteer retention rate for the future.

The course was finally attended by 16 persons with 11 present over the 2 days. Despite the proverbial delays to get going in the morning as per plan, the sessions were not rushed and topics adequately covered by the different resource persons, to whom SIM is thankful. The active participation, interaction and questions of the participants are indications of the success of the event. Most participants were not aware and even surprised by the extent of SIM's activities, carried out through its numerous "arms" such as Kids Club, Teens Club, Young Muslimah, Young Muslims, SIM, WIM, IIET, Masjid Reduit and Pont Souillac Senior Citizens Association and its Da'wah, Education and Training and Social Engagement Departments. We were almost reprimanded that we do not expose our activities enough, especially in such forums as the Quranic Arabic Classes and participants had the impression that SIM was a closed group, which it is certainly not.

For everyone, participants and organisers, the Induction Course is a must and has to be repeated for all who are involved with and who wish to know SIM.

Finally, a word on the venue is important. Notwithstanding the fact that some participants may have expected an air conditioned hall, we had to make do with a cosy verandah which although sheltered was hot and somewhat uncomfortable specially in the afternoon. However, we did our best to compensate with appropriate reorganisation of the seating arrangements and good food. But overall the environment was pleasing and provided participants with an opportunity to escape from their normal surroundings.

SIM is currently collaborating with Zakaat Hub which is a body regrouping many Islamic NGOs – The aim of which is to create an e-platform where information can be shared among the NGOs with respect to zakaat cases. The idea is to handle cases more effectively while controlling issues such as duplicates, fake cases etc. A medical team has also been set up to provide guidance on medical zakaat applications.

IMAHPA SIM Virtual Conference

The Islamic Medical and Allied Health Professional Association (IMAHPA) in collaboration with the Societe Islamique de Maurice (SIM) organized a Ramadan and Health Virtual Conference on Saturday 10th April 2021 at 20.30 to welcome the month of Ramadan in a spiritual yet healthy mood. The event took place on the ZOOM platform and was coordinated by the E-SIM department consisting of brothers Waziim, Yameen and Yasfeer. Thanks to them, the live event was broadcasted on Youtube and received over 800 views.

The event was chaired by Dr Ridhwaan Badurally Adam from the IMAHPA. He introduced Dr Yaasir Ozeer who spoke on the management of Diabetes in Ramadan followed by nutritionist, Sr Ibteesam Pendor. She explained about the dos and don'ts in Ramadan and gave examples of ideal foods and drinks to be consumed in the right proportions as well as delicacies and sweets in moderation. Br Waliid Roojee outlined several aspects of physical exercise and their importance while fasting. Exercise is important to the human body to maintain and improve health and the support of all bodily organs. Even during Ramadan, it is recommended whether it's your daily walk or the gym.

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Effective Parenting Course

'O vous qui avez cru ! Préservez vos personnes et vos familles, d'un feu dont le combustible sera les gens et les pierres, surveillé par les Anges rudes, durs, ne désobéissant jamais à Allah en ce qu'il leur commande, et faisant strictement ce qu'on leur ordonne'. (Surah At-Tahrim, verset 6)

Soucieux du malaise social et la dégradation de la cellule familiale que nous côtoyons dans notre quotidien, SIM se lance cette année dans une formation intensive de 20 semaines afin d'accompagner les parents et ainsi que les futurs parents dans cette tâche délicate qu'Allah (swt) nous a donnée.

Ce cours comprend un échange entre les parents et divers professionnels tels les médecins, da'eas, psychologues, sociologues, éducateurs et des travailleurs sociaux. Les parents n'ont plus de repères et se sentent souvent seuls pour élever leurs enfants face à tant de fléaux sociaux, de tentations, d'influences médiatiques etc...

Les sessions ont commencé le samedi 20 Février 2021 au centre d'IET à Moka entre 13.30 à 15.30. Nos trois premiers modules étaient sur le couple comme un fondement solide de la famille, l'enfant comme un Amanah qu'Allah nous a confié, l'importance de la famille et les phases de développement physique et psychologique de l'enfant. D'autres modules à venir seront sur le développement des valeurs et de la personnalité, la nutrition et l'hygiène de l'enfant, l'éducation sexuelle afin de conscientiser nos enfants des dangers, des lois visant à protéger la famille et les enfants et comment développer la créativité de l'enfant.

Alhamdullillah, tout se passe bien jusqu'à présent et qu'Allah nous aide à atteindre notre but. Aameen.

Rénovation de l'IIET

En décembre nous vous informions de notre démarche de trouver des investisseurs pour notre projet « foot-five ». Nous avons essayé de trouver des bailleurs de fonds pour financer le projet sous une formule de « Cash Wakf ». Malheureusement, vu la somme de Rs 2.5m, cela n'a pas abouti surtout que les investisseurs potentiels préfèrent en cette période de COVID19, venir en aide aux personnes de la communauté qui sont économiquement dans le besoin.



Notre deuxième option est un prêt de la part des frères et sœurs qui sont disposé à engager leur argent à long terme. Etant donné que l'intention avérée du projet, en sus d'éloigner les jeunes d'activités illégales perverses ou dangereuses, est d'avoir des revenus qui seront utilisés pour financer la Da'wah, ainsi que des projets éducatifs et sociaux, y mettre son bien pourrait sans doute rapporter sa somme de thawaab jaariya, in sha Allah.

La troisième option est de monter un partenariat avec des frères et sœurs qui voudraient bien investir avec nous pour exploiter commercialement ce projet sur une base BOT (Build Operate Transfer). In sha Allah très bientôt nous aurons un business plan que nous pourrons présenter à nos membres, sympathisants et investisseurs potentiels.

Il faut dire qu'il avait l'art de faire aimer la biologie même au plus réfractaire car il était passionné et communiquait merveilleusement sa passion à d'autres. Je me souviens encore, comme si c'était hier, de ces nombreux filles et garçons qui venaient à la maison pour se perfectionner en biologie en passant pas la porte latérale qui donne sur son bureau. Il fut un temps où j'en faisais partie.

Il était également craint et respecté en tant que principal de collège à Port Louis et à Flacq puis en tant proviseur adjoint à John Kennedy. Parmi ses élèves, nombreux sont ceux qui ont poursuivi de grandes études universitaires et ont connu des carrières exceptionnelles dont un ex premier ministre.

Il sera souvenu comme quelqu'un qui était charmant, adorable, attachant et fidèle, un croyant qui haïssait les extrêmes et un monothéiste pur qui ne supportait pas les intermédiaires.
