Cérémonie de Remise de Certificats

La Société Islamique de Maurice (SIM) a organisé une cérémonie de remise de certificats pour les étudiants qui ont complété les niveaux 1 et 2 du cours de « Quranic Arabic », le dimanche 19 novembre 2023 à l'Auditorium Octave Wiehe, Réduit. La cérémonie s'est déroulée en présence de l'honorable Mme Leela Devi Dookun, GCSK, Vice-Premier ministre et Ministre de l'Éducation, de l'Enseignement supérieur, de la Science et de la Technologie, l'honorable Anwar Husnoo, Vice-Premier ministre et Ministre des Collectivités locales et de la Gestion des catastrophes, et l'honorable Mme Fazila Jeewa Daureeawoo, Ministre de la Sécurité sociale et de la Solidarité nationale. Environ 400 personnes, dont des étudiants et leur famille ont répondu à notre invitation.

Le cours d'arabe coranique a débuté en 2005 avec une classe, à l'Institute of Islamic Education and Training (IIET) à Moka. Aujourd'hui, le cours se déroule dans sept lieux différents, répartis à travers l'île. A ce jour, plus de 2 000 étudiants, tout âge confondu, ont complété le niveau 1 du cours. Chaque année, environ 150 étudiants sont inscrits au niveau 1 et 75 au niveau 2. SIM propose désormais de développer des niveaux 3 et 4. qui comprendront l'explication thématique du Saint Coran.

La cérémonie, qui a débuté à 9h30, comprenait, mise à part la remise des certificats, un jeu de rôle par des étudiants sur l'importance de comprendre le message du Coran, une initiation à l'arabe coranique et plusieurs témoignages.

SIM remercie tous ces enseignants bénévoles qui de semaine en semaine consacrent leur temps à enseigner le dernier livre révélé de Dieu à l'humanité.

La campagne pour l'admission de 2024 a déjà débuté. Les cours seront dispensés aux endroits suivants : Madrassah Ruknuddin à Port Louis, Collège Hamilton à Mahebourg, Collège Doha à Curepipe, Centre Sir A.R Mohamed à Phoenix, Collège Islamic à Belle Rose, Masjid Muttaqi à Plaine des Papayes et Masjid Ar-Rahmat à Flacq

La cérémonie a aussi été l'occasion pour SIM de revenir sur ses 50 ans de contribution à la société. Créée en 1971, la SIM est devenue l'une des organisations principales dans le domaine de la Da'wah, de l'éducation et du développement de la jeunesse.

Family Life Education

Visit of Br Edris Khamissa

SIM and the Human Welfare League (HWL) organised a one-week joint programme by Br Edris Khamissa from South Africa. Br Edris Khamissa is an educational consultant of International repute. He has also been actively involved in developing Parental Education and Couple Counselling. This visit came at an opportune moment when SIM had embarked since 2021 on a Parenting programme.

The programme started on the 28 November and was concluded on 2 December 2023.

The major programmes were as follows:

Training Course for Educators

A Training Course for some 65 Educators held at the Doha Secondary School.

Most Muslim Colleges sent some of their Educators to this programme.

Major Take away from this course are as follows:

- 1- Academic success is not a predictor of real success.
- 2- A Teacher is not a sage on a stage but a guide on the side
- 3- How do students learn?
 - 5% by lecture method
 - 20% by Audio Visual presentation
 - 30% by group demonstration
 - 50% by group discussion
 - 75% by doing it
 - 90% by teaching it to others

4-The 7 great attributes of teachers are as follows:

- 1-They are creative- Our Nabi (saw) was a very creative person
- 2-Make relevant lessons
- 3-They connect with each learner
- 4-They are fair
- 5-They provide Holistic Education
- 6-They have a sense of Humour
- 7-They develop the students' potential by making them ask the right question



Meeting with representatives of Muslims Schools

A meeting was held with school administrators of five colleges. The purpose of this meeting was to explore the possibility of forming an Association of Muslim Schools. Br E Khamissa who is one of the founders of the AMS South Africa, explained the benefits of such a venture. All those present agreed to the launch of such a noble association which will bring a lot of experience sharing and networking with similar bodies in the UK and South Africa.

Conference on Challenges of Parenting and Why marriage fails?

Two conferences were also organised 1- at the Sir A Razack Mohamed sub Hall and a second one at the Rabita Hall.

Parenting Programme and Marital Counselling

As far as our Parenting programme and Marital Relations are concerned, our members had the opportunity to have a good meeting with Br Khamissa and a roadmap was developed on the way forward. The two workshops also attracted a good number of participants and most agreed to join one of the two groups to develop their own potential and eventually to spearhead the project of Parental Education and Marital Counselling.





Given the success of this programme, SIM, the HWL and the Doha Secondary School Administration agreed to jointly organise a two-week programme in 2024 insha Allah. In the meantime, SIM will insha Allah receive the support of Br Khamissa to organise regular online programme on Parenting and Marital Relations.

We had 2 beautiful outings during the year. *Alhamdullillah*, we brought the participants to an Artistic exhibition at the House of Digital Art in Port Louis and to a horse riding session in Bel Ombre in order to promote a sport practiced by our beloved Prophet Muhammad (PBUH). We also introduced some basic skills of archery to our participants.

Last but not least, I would like to express our thanks to our young participants of Teens Club who offered all their support during the organisation of our annual Food Day at SIM in November. We are very proud of them. May Allah bless them on this right path n protect our children always.

KIDS CLUB








Since the beginning of the War on Gaza, SIM has issued, published on its web site or mailed a number of communications which demonstrates its stand on the issue. These are given below:

Tu me soumets à tes caprices et convertis mon pays en labyrinthe, avec tes points de contrôle permanents et autres barrages routiers, doublé d'un régime de permis draconien, soutenu par un système répressif de surveillance

Tes balles en caoutchouc estropient quand elles ne tuent pas.

Tes prisons hébergent sans procès ceux qui se rebellent et enferment sans honte ni regret nos sœurs et nos enfants.

Avec la complicité de ta cour de justice, tu t'évertues à dépouiller mes pairs de leurs demeures.

Las d'être ignoré par le reste du monde, y compris par mes frères qui vendent leur âme pour quelques deniers et pactent avec l'ennemi, je me révolte enfin.

Je me suis mis à transpercer tes murs de l'occupation et enrayer ton dôme de défense.

Surpris par mon audace et mon ingéniosité, tu n'as eu d'autres réflexes que de me faire passer pour un terroriste, moi qui combats pour mon honneur, ma dignité et ma liberté.

J'ai des fléchettes et toi des missiles. Quand je te pique, tu prétextes des douleurs comme si je t'ai éventré.

Puis tu rougis de colère, rugis et déchaînes ton ire sur ma mère et mes enfants.

Tu réduis ma prison en gravats, tu éteins mes lumières et tu me prives de vivres et d'eau.

Et le monde, sauf les Justes, t'applaudit, te soutient et me calomnie.

Et tu crois que je ne vois pas où tu veux en venir. Tu veux m'exterminer comme tu as essayé d'exterminer mes ancêtres.

Si les pseudos puissants de ce monde te cautionnent et te soutiennent, sache que les prières de l'Oumma sont avec moi.

Je ne sais pas ce que l'avenir me réserve. Mais ce que je sais, c'est qu'Allah me voit et m'entend et je me remets à Lui.

Demain je serai peut-être martyre, mais je garde espoir et je sais que d'autres Palestiniens naîtront et un jour tu ne sauras pas où te cacher.

We wish to congratulate you on your stand with regards to the Israel-Gaza Genocide.

The UN is supposed to be the body that regulates the affairs of the world to ensure that justice and fairness prevail, that the weak is not trodden upon.

A state conducting itself in such a way that it consistently ignores the views of fellow members, is tantamount to proclaiming that it is superior to all others and stand in no need of advice or checks from others.

Therefore, such a state should have no say in the affairs of the world and should, with immediate effect, be either suspended or expelled from the United Nations.

We humbly request the Secretary-General of this august organisation to forthwith suspend and exclude Israel from all instances of the United Nations and let it be the rogue state that it is, deserving no respect from fellow nations of the world and with no say in the affairs of the world.

Its actions against the Palestinians in general and the population of Gaza in particular in this grave moment where so far more than 3500 children have been slaughtered without any iota of pity or remorse shows a complete lack of humanity and respect for human dignity.

Palestine la suite

Ça y est. Les massacres ont repris à Gaza après 7 jours de trêve. On s'y attendait, n'est-ce pas ?

Ilan Pappe, historien israélien, dans son livre « The Ethnic Cleansing of Palestine » (Le nettoyage ethnique de la Palestine) nous dit ceci :

« Le nettoyage ethnique est un effort visant à rendre homogène un pays ethniquement mixte en expulsant un groupe particulier de personnes et en les transformant en réfugiés tout en démolissant les maisons dont ils ont été chassés. Il existe peut-être un plan directeur, mais la plupart des troupes engagées dans le nettoyage ethnique n'ont pas besoin d'ordres directs : elles savent d'avance ce que l'on attend d'elles. Des massacres accompagnent les opérations, mais là où ils se produisent, ils ne font pas partie d'un plan génocidaire : ils constituent une tactique clé pour accélérer la fuite de la population destinée à l'expulsion. Plus tard, les expulsés sont alors effacés de l'histoire officielle et populaire du pays et excisés de la mémoire collective. De la phase de planification à l'exécution finale, ce qui s'est produit en Palestine en 1948 constitue un cas clair, selon ces définitions éclairées et savantes, de nettoyage ethnique. » (Traduit de l'anglais)

Nous n'étions pas témoins des événements de 1948 car nous n'étions pas encore nés.

Nous sommes en 2023. Ce qui se passe à Gaza et en Cisjordanie ressemble étrangement à ce qui est décrit par Pappe, sinon en plus violent, en plus déshumanisant.

On a l'impression qu'à l'ère de la robotique et de l'intelligence artificielle, même le porte-parole de l'armée israélienne au visage inexpressif, rabâche des mots générés par une machine. Il annonce savoir où se trouvent précisément ses cibles. Mais ses missiles et obus

détruisent des centaines de vies innocentes, rien que pour atteindre une personne ou un fictif centre de commandement. Dommages collatéraux ? Ce terme n'est plus d'actualité. La vérité c'est que tu sais pertinemment bien ce que tu es en train de faire : l'extermination d'un peuple devant un parterre de chiots sans dents, protégé par ton pitbull à la robe étoilée. Des bâtiments historiques et des musées, avec leurs manuscrits témoins du glorieux passé de Gaza sont réduits au silence.

Israël dit savoir où se trouvent les hauts gradés du Hamas, mais ne sait pas où les otages sont gardés. Pour se donner bonne conscience, il se dépêchera de blâmer le Hamas si ses compatriotes succombent sous le tir de ses propres armes de destruction massive. Reste-t-il un iota d'humanité dans l'armée israélienne ? Un enfant est tué chaque dix minutes. Que dis-je ? Je vois défiler devant mes yeux des enfants blessés, amputés, estropiés à vie, traumatisés et je suis à court de mots pour décrire ce que je vois à travers des rideaux de larmes. Tant de désolations ! Des grands-pères en pleurs errent parmi les décombres, cherchant leurs petits-enfants. Des enfants fuient les bombes, les yeux hagards, D'autres sont sujets à des tremblements incontrôlables. Des mères s'agrippent à leurs enfants décédés.

S'il y avait un semblant de retenue avant la trêve, désormais c'est « en avant toute ». C'est la bestialité qui déferle sur Gaza. C'est la haine qui déverse son venin. Le Pharaon de l'Oppression et le Pharaon de l'Exode renaissent.

Le Palestinien n'est-t-il devenu pour toi, fils du Sionisme, qu'une statistique ? Quel jeu machiavélique as-tu encore inventé ? Tu le déplaces sur un échiquier de ton invention pour le protéger dis-tu, ou plutôt pour l'exiler sur un bout de terre trop exigüe pour contenir son peuple.

Prochaine étape : Gazer Gaza ?

Extermination en masse ? C'était à prévoir.

De quel syndrome souffres-tu ? La victime qui reproduit les actes de son bourreau ?

Holocauste 2 ! Dieu nous en préserve !

Quid de la Cisjordanie ?

Des tireurs d'élite sévissent. Des enfants sont abattus. Des maisons sont investies par les soldats. Des enfants, des femmes et des hommes sont menacés, emprisonnés et torturés pour des peccadilles ou à cause d'un « like ». Des maisons sont perquisitionnées, saccagées, pilonnées ou rasées. Des rues sont éventrées délibérément, au moyen de bulldozers. Des commerçants sont harcelés. Des colons illégaux s'enhardissent et terrorisent, armés par le gouvernement et protégés par des soldats. Combien de détenus palestiniens tu as libérés contre des otages israéliens pendant la trêve ? Tu t'es dépêché de les remplacer après la trêve et ce, avec des intérêts en plus.

Que la Malédiction de Dieu te frappe ! Que Dieu te réserve la fin que tu mérites ! Quant à moi, je continue de prier et d'invoquer Dieu pour qu'il bénisse ce peuple admirable de Palestine, pour qu'il lui réserve une place de choix dans Son paradis. Ameen !

La SIM soutient le GM sud-africain.

La Société Islamique de Maurice, communément connue sous le nom de Société Islamique de Maurice et des Mascareignes (SIM), représentant la communauté musulmane de Maurice et agissant en tant que mouvement de la société civile, exprime par la présente son soutien sans équivoque à la décision du gouvernement sud-africain de renvoyer l'affaire israélienne Gouvernement à la Cour Internationale de Justice.
